### An Enchanted Memory Tour

Your journey begins with a tour at the Carroll County Farm Museum where costumed guides interpret life during the late 1800's. Craft demonstrations may include broom-making, quilting, blacksmithing or wood carving. Lunch is served in award-winning style at the carefully restored antebellum mansion, Antrim 1844. Shop 'til you drop at A Greater Gift Shop which offers thousands of handcrafted items from over 30 countries — museum-quality gift items at reasonable prices.

### A Classic Country Tour

Your day begins with a dose of history at the Union Mills Homestead and Grist Mill. You will retrace the steps of the six-generation Shriver family who entertained Union and Confederate soldiers just hours apart before the Battle of Gettysburg. Then you can watch 19th-century technology at the restored mill and take home some stone-ground flour from the gift shop. The Carroll County Farm Museum is the next stop with many self-directed choices for your group. Tour the main house, watch the many crafts people, or stroll the old-fashioned flower garden. Enjoy a relaxing box lunch in the restored barn or under the big, old oak trees. Finish your day at the Historical Society of Carroll County where the exhibits will take you back to bygone years with items from your past.

### Progressive Lunch Tour

Begin your tour at Johannson's Dining House, located on Westminster's quaint Main Street. Then ride through Uniontown, a one-street village frozen in time, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Enjoy your main entrée and a tour at Antrim 1844, an award-winning antebellum mansion. Then off to the Carroll County Farm Museum to witness rural life in the 19th-century. Tour the dormitory rooms to observe artisans quilt, make brooms, carve wood or visit the blacksmith out in the shed. Finish the day with tea and dessert at Gypsy's Tea Room, located in the historic William Winchester house. Upstairs you will find time to shop for special gifts for your family and friends.

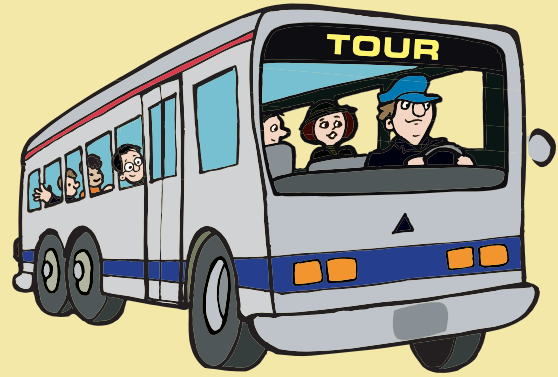
