This route is intended for experienced, well conditioned cyclists. It is extremely hilly, with steep climbs and descents. Roads are narrow with no shoulders, but have low traffic volumes. It uses some of the C & O Canal National Historic Park towpath and a pedestrian bridge to cross the Potomac River. Riders should be prepared to carry bicycles up the stairs to the pedestrian bridge. Food and water are only available at Sharpsburg and Harpers Ferry.
