Thousands of **Baltimore Students** will visit ships, historic sites, and aircraft for STEM educational experiences, through both onsite activations and virtual engagement.





Nearly half of attendees (48%) are under age 35, while 20% of attendees are between the ages of 35-49, and 32% are age 50+.

Nearly two-thirds of attendees earned a four-year degree or higher.

More than one in three visitors (44.7%) has a household income above \$75,000.


