International Underground Railroad Month celebrates the inspiring efforts of people who fought for freedom of the enslaved. It honors those who resisted enslavement and made the daring decision to escape, those who provided places of refuge for freedom seekers, those who guided others or helped them along the way, but most importantly those who courageously risked their lives to find liberation. Several iconic freedom seekers such as Harriet Tubman and Frederick Douglass broke chains of enslavement and fled in September.

During International Underground Railroad Month, the Maryland Office of Tourism and its partners highlight and share stories of Maryland's Underground Railroad. Events, tours, and visitor experiences inspire people to travel to Underground Railroad locations. Here, individuals discover the extraordinary stories of freedom seekers' journeys, illuminating the hope for freedom for all people.

In 2024 we are featuring Underground Railroad sites and stories in the Southern Region of Maryland, including St. Mary's, Calvert, and Charles counties, and the southern areas of Prince George's and Anne Arundel counties. Our theme is "Finding Freedom, Faith and Family on Maryland's Underground Railroad." The decision to flee enslavement or stay behind often depended upon family and faith connections. Family connections were often crucial in getting assistance needed to find freedom. Freedom seekers summoned the help of family or friends on their journeys. Some freedom seekers made the decision to flee in order to rejoin loved ones. Others could not bear the pain of leaving children behind and decided to stay enslaved where they could stay connected to their loved ones.

Today, descendants of these 18th and 19th-century enslaved communities honor their ancestors and seek unity and healing. They volunteer at Network to Freedom sites to tell their ancestors' stories and preserve historic resources significant in their families' pasts.

The new Finding Freedom, Faith and Family on Maryland's Underground Railroad guide will feature a collection of Underground Railroad sites in the Southern Maryland Region and a walking tour of Historic Annapolis. Web content will provide additional details on each of these sites, highlighting the individual stories of these freedom seekers and exploring the obstacles and opportunities for flight in Southern Maryland, such as fleeing to military lines during the War of 1812 and the Civil War.
